If you have elected to receive property tax assessmentnotices, as permitted by Idaho Code § 63-308, and/or property tax notices as permitted by Idaho Code § 63-902, electronically, by clicking "Register", you acknowledge that you have carefully read the Terms and Conditions regarding electronic delivery and consent and agree to receive documents electronically as set forth therein.

## Terms and Conditions Regarding Electronic Delivery

By selecting electronic delivery you agree that the annual and/or supplemental property valuation assessmentnotice required by Idaho Code § 63-308 and/or the annual and/or supplemental property tax notice required by Idaho Code§ 63-902 will no longer be sent to you via U.S.mail. Instead, you will receive notification via email, to the email addressyou provide, that your property valuation assessment and/or your property tax notice has been posted to your account as an eStatement. Your eStatement accessed establishing profile must be online by personal login at https://valleycountyid.viewyourinfo.com. By accessing your eStatement on line, you can review, print, copy or download your annual notice. eStatements will be available online for five (5) years after the date of posting.

This election applies only to your property valuation assessmentnotice and/or your property tax notice required by Idaho Code§ 63-308 and Idaho Code§ 63-902, and to courtesy reminders and notifications, not required by law. All other notices required by law will continue to be sent via U.S.mail. You may request a free paper copy of your notice(s) at any time without affecting your online election.

To access your eStatement you will need a computer or other electronic device with an internet browser that supports 128-bit encryption; a valid personal email address; and Adobe Acrobat Reader version 10.0 or above. You can download Adobe Acrobat Reader for free by clicking http://get.adobe.com/reader/

You are responsible for providing a valid email address and for notifying us if your email address changes. You may report a change of email address by 1) accessing your account online and changing your personal profile information at <a href="http://co.valley.id.us/assessors-office">http://co.valley.id.us/assessors-office</a>; 2) sending notification via email to <a href="mailto-estatements@co.valley.id.us">estatements@co.valley.id.us</a>; 3) sending notification via U.S. mail to the Valley County Assessorand the Valley County Tax Collector, P.O. Box 1350, Cascade, ID 83611; 4) or by calling (208) 454-7355. If we receive a change of email address, you will receive a confirmation of the change. You may also change your election for electronic delivery at any time utilizing these same methods. If you change your election, a confirmation of your change and subsequently your property notice(s) will be sent via U.S.Mail to the last known addressof record.

Sendingnotification to the email addresson file with the Valley County Assessor and/or the Valley County Treasurer has the same legal effect as if the annual or supplemental property notices have been mailed to the property owner via U.S.mail. Failure to retrieve or receive your yearly or supplemental notices as described above, does not invalidate assessment valuation appeal deadlines and does not excuse any late fees or penalties if the amount due is not paid timely, nor does it invalidate any collection procedures as required by law for the State of Idaho. Your email address will not be used for any purpose unrelated to facilitating the notifications described above.
